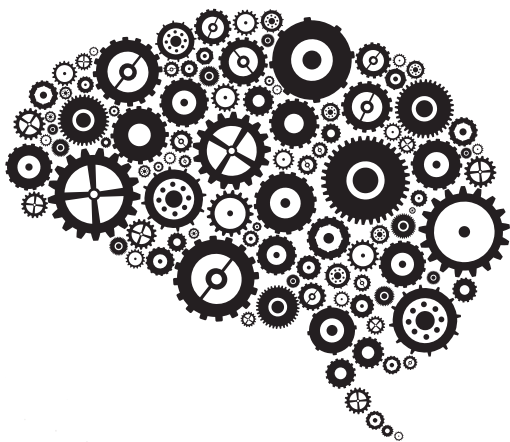

THE IMPORTANCE OF A SHARP MIND

There are countless sayings, adages and aphorisms involving the human brain. The mind is a terrible thing to waste, being the most prominent and poignant, speaks directly to the importance of keeping the brain active. But how, exactly, does one keep the brain active?

THE BENEFITS OF SHARP MIND GAMES

One of the biggest things you learn by solving puzzles of all kinds is the ability to think outside of the box for a solution. This type of thinking literally hardwires the brain to solve tougher problems by examining more than what's typically confined in the narrow scope of problem-solving.

Being mentally sharp and actually exercising the brain helps in many areas. For starters, it helps neurons to fire faster, more frequently, and thus help you make quick work of everyday problems.

Staying sharp and training the brain also increases your overall intelligence. Ever wonder why those super-smart people are so brilliant? What's different about their brains from an average person's brain? It's the ability to absorb and understand knowledge. A trained brain retains knowledge and builds pathways for the recollection of answers.

You may never be trapped on the 85th floor with only 20 feet of rope, a tennis shoe and a pocket knife, but if you are, the sharp mind can craft an out-of-the-box way out of that situation, whereas the dull mind has very limited options.

HOW TO PLAY

Welcome to cross training for your brain! Just like athletes improve their overall performance by strengthening a variety of muscle groups, this book is designed to keep your brain stimulated and active in a variety of ways.
